DAY -01

DATE: 15-03-2023

On the first day of the NSS Special camp inauguration of the programme started with lighting of the lamps and welcoming of the guests. The programme proceeded with special speech on history, aims and objective given by our teacher-in-charge Dr Kartick Saha and guest present for the ceremony. On the first day of the camp, poster making competition on the theme “Girl Child Education” and “Clean Environment Green Environment” was conducted. We ended day 1 with the distribution of pencil, eraser, and ruler to the primary students with the aim to promote ‘Right to education’ as one of the fundamental rights under Article 21-A.



DAY-2

DATE: 16-03-2023

During NSS Special camp day 2, on the first half of the day we conducted ‘Yoga Session’ to promote mental health care among youths. On the second half of the day special lecture on “Awareness on conservation of environment and beat plastic pollution” was delivered by Assistant Prof. Soma Sarkel, department of geography, Bakshirhat Mahavidyalaya. The programme continued with various act on moral teachings that was performed by NSS Volunteers with a view to inculcate moral values among primary students and finally we concluded the day by distributing chocolates to kids with motive to make them proper use of dust bin.



DAY-3
DATE :17-03-2023

During Day 3 NSS Special camp, Awareness on Child Marriage and Child Protection was conducted . On this day we had invited Mr Nirupam Roy BLC member of NGO and his team to deliver a special session on Child Marriage and Child Protection. A good number of students had participated on the programme. A short flim on 'Child Marriage' and knowledge on 'Good Tough and Bad Tough' was taught to the children on this day.



DAY-4
DATE:18-03-2023

On day 4 of the NSS Special camp we started the day with cleaning campaign on the main bazar area of Bhanukumari I. The slogan of the campaign was 'Plastic hatao paryavaran bachao'. We collected large amount of plastic from the road side and made local people aware of making environment clean and green and make plastic free zone. After this, the programme continued by planting fruit trees at primary school. Total of 20 different varieties fruit trees were planted by the NSS volunteers with the school kids. On the second half of the special camp 4th day training on self defence and marital art by NSS Volunteer Miss Beauty Sarkar and her team Bakshirhat Taekwondo Club at Primary school was performed to encourage women self defence and Nari Sakti .



DAY -5
DATE:19-03-2023

On the 5th day of the special camp tree plantations drive was taken place at surrounding areas of Bhanukumari I with the view of keeping environment clean and green.



DAY-6
DATE:20-03-2023

On day 6 of the special camp started with flower plantations by NSS volunteers and school children at Junior High School to motivate students to keep surrounding green and lively. After this event we had organised door to door awareness campaign on 'Dengue Preventive measures', we visited around 53 surrounding household near market area and distributed pamphlets to make local resident aware of Dengue focusing on its causes, prevention, symptoms, and precaution. Since day 6 of the special camp was held on the nutritious week of the primary school so on this day Mid Day Meal was contributed and served by the NSS volunteers. On the second half of the day we had invited Officer-in-charge of Bakshirhat police station to the special camp to create awareness among Youths on 'Traffic and Road Safety', steps to be taken for preventing road accidents, use of vehicle lights and horn, wearing seat belt and helmet.



DAY-7
DATE:21-03-2023

Cultural activities have several practical implications. Keeping in view that by participating in such activities, the students become more passionate and confident on the final day of the special camp we had organised a cultural event. On this day each volunteer had participated on various activities like singing, dancing, recitation of poem, acts and so on. Finally the seven days special camp was successfully ended with the Valedictory and feedback session.
